INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON TONNAGE MEASUREMENT OF SHIPS, 1969

Accession by Nauru

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the International Convention on Tonnage Measurement of Ships, done at London on 23 June 1969, and to state that, in accordance with article 16(2) of the Convention, accession by the Republic of Nauru was effected by deposit of an instrument on 18 June 2018.

The Convention will enter into force for Nauru on 18 September 2018, in accordance with its article 17(3).

There are, at present, 157 Contracting States to the Convention, representing approximately 99.09%* of the gross tonnage of the world's merchant shipping.
