INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON LOAD LINES, 1966

Accession by Uganda

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the International Convention on Load Lines, done at London on 5 April 1966, and to state that, in accordance with article 27 of the Convention, accession by the Republic of Uganda was effected by the deposit of an instrument on 10 October 2019.

The Convention will enter into force for Uganda on 10 January 2020, in accordance with article 28(3).

There are, at present, 163 Contracting States to the Convention, representing approximately 99.03%* of the gross tonnage of the world's merchant shipping.
