CONVENTION ON LIMITATION OF LIABILITY FOR MARITIME CLAIMS, 1976

Accession by the Islamic Republic of Iran

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the Convention on Limitation of Liability for Maritime Claims, 1976, and to state that, in accordance with the relevant provisions of article 16(3), accession by the Islamic Republic of Iran was effected by deposit of an instrument on 1 September 2015.

The instrument of accession was accompanied by the following reservation:

"The Government of the Islamic Republic of Iran reserves its right to exclude the application of the provisions of article 2, paragraphs (d) and (e), according to article 18(1) of the Convention."

The Convention will enter into force for the Islamic Republic of Iran on 1 December 2015, in accordance with article 17(3).

There are, at present, 54 Contracting States to the Convention.
