**PROTOCOL OF 1976 TO THE ATHENS CONVENTION RELATING TO
THE CARRIAGE OF PASSENGERS AND THEIR
LUGGAGE BY SEA, 1974**

Denunciation by Georgia

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to article V of the Protocol of 1976 to the Athens Convention relating to the Carriage of Passengers and their Luggage by Sea, 1974 (PAL PROT 1976), the terms of which provide that a Contracting State may denounce the Protocol at any time after its entry into force for that State.

The Protocol of 2002 to the Athens Convention relating to the Carriage of Passengers and their Luggage by Sea, 1974 (PAL PROT 2002) to which Georgia acceded on 22 May 2019, provides in article 17(5) as follows:

"A State shall not express its consent to be bound by this Protocol unless, if Party thereto, it denounces:

- (a) the Athens Convention relating to the Carriage of Passengers and their Luggage by Sea, done at Athens on 13 December 1974;
- (b) the Protocol to the Athens Convention relating to the Carriage of Passengers and their Luggage by Sea, done at London on 19 November 1976; and
- (c) the Protocol of 1990 to amend the Athens Convention relating to the Carriage of Passengers and their Luggage by Sea, done at London on 29 March 1990,

with effect from the time that this Protocol shall enter into force for that State in accordance with article 20."

The Secretary-General has the honour to state that denunciation of PAL PROT 1976 by Georgia was effected by means of an instrument of denunciation received on 22 May 2019.

In accordance with article 17(5) of PAL PROT 2002, the denunciation of PAL PROT 1976 will take effect for Georgia on 22 August 2019, the day on which PAL PROT 2002 will enter into force for Georgia.
