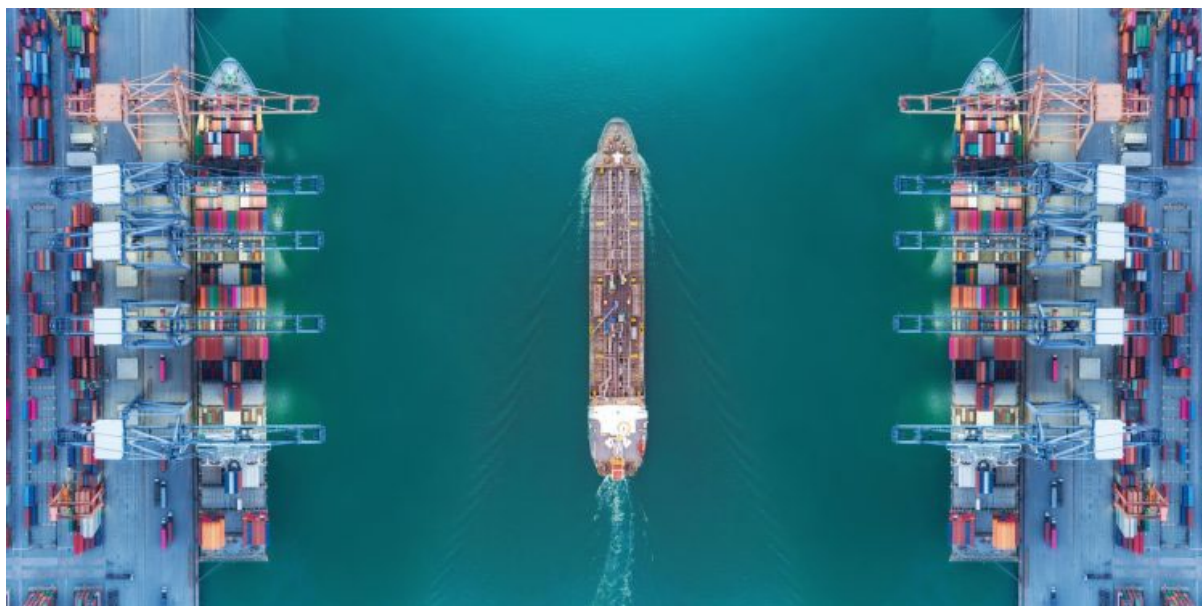
This circular replaces all previously issued circulars under this title.

The attachment to this circular includes the "**List of national operational contact points responsible for the receipt, transmission and processing of urgent reports on incidents involving harmful substances including oil from ships to coastal States**".

These contact points can also be used for PSC matters, Casualty investigation services and Ships' inspection services.

The information on national contact points can be accessed through GISIS for:

- National inspection services – head offices (originally MSC/Circ.630)
- National inspection services – local offices (originally MSC/Circ.630)
- Inspection services acting as representatives of flag States for port State control matters and responsible authorities in charge of casualty investigation (originally MSC/Circ.542)
- Secretariats of Memoranda of Understanding on Port State Control.



The attached list is also issued as the annex to the MSC-MEPC.6 circular posted annually on IMODOCS on 31 January of each year. Quarterly updates are subsequently issued on 30 April, 31 July and 31 October of each year. While the most up-to-date version of the list can be downloaded from the GISIS Contact Points module.

The next circular under this title (MSC-MEPC.6/Circ.24) will be issued on 31 January 2026
